If you wish to Appeal a decision issued by the Judiciary Committee (JC) or the General Purposes Tribunal (GPT), then as per By-laws Part 4A, Section 10 "Appeals Committee" a), b) and c) and Part 4B, Section 18 "Appeals Committee" c), d) and e);

- Appeals must be in writing to the SGFA General Manager via email info@sgfa.com.au accompanied with a fee of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) which will be refunded if the Appeal is upheld.
- The Appeal must be lodged within seven (7) days of the publication of the decision.
- Appeals are to be based on the following grounds only:
 - Failure to afford procedural fairness;
 - Lack of jurisdiction;
 - Insufficient evidence;
 - Incorrect interpretation of By-laws; or
 - Severity of sentence (except minimum sentence).
- If this form is not received within the seven (7) days of the decision being notified, plus the prescribed fee, then the appeal will not heard.
- Any mandatory suspension of one (1) match or a minimum suspension, as outlined in By-law Part 4A, cannot be appealed.
- A copy of the Send-off or Incident report can be emailed prior to the Appeal Meeting (refer below).
